Research & Questions



Research Your Employer and the Role

Take some time to do some research on the health care facility you are being interviewed for. This will show interest on your side and employers will appreciate it.



Prepare Questions for the Employer

Write down all the open questions you want to ask to your potential employer. They can be about your tasks as a nurse and the work environment among other topics.



Anticipate Questions

Put yourself in the employer's position and think about questions in German they might ask you. Write them down and include your answers as well when taking notes.

Professional Appearance



Dress for Success

Dress professionally to make a good impression. Ask your peers or college friends what they wore for their interviews if you have any doubts.



Technical Check

At least one day before the interview, do a technical check. Ensure that both your video and microphone are working, and search for a calm space with no background noise.



Get to Know the Interview Platform

Whether you're invited through Google Meetup, Zoom or Skype, make sure you download the program and review its corresponding website in advance.

During the Interview



Punctuality

Punctuality is a sign of commitment. To avoid any issues, have your device ready at least 20 minutes before the interview and log into the call.



Don't Memorize, Be Authentic

Your answers should come naturally, as you are the one who knows your professional experience best.



No Show, Let Us Know

If you can't make it to the interview, always let us know so that we can reschedule. This will prevent you from giving a bad impression to the employer.
